






















Northerly Park Master Plan Schedule



March/Early April - Site Committee Meetings (2)

April 15 - Public Engagement Kickoff – Social Pinpoint

April 24 – Site Visit and Open House – 5pm to 7 pm at Jerry's Bar and Restaurant

Mid-Late May – Report that Summarizes Issues, Opportunities, Priorities, and Goals of Park

Late May – Preliminary Master Plan with 3 Concepts

June 11 – County Commission Meeting at Angle Inlet – Master Plan will be a topic

Mid-June to early July – Social Pinpoint additional input on Preliminary Master Plan

Early August - Steering Committee Meeting to choose Concept to move forward

September – Compiled Master Plan and Report


September 30 – Approve Master Plan




